The detailed tender documents may be had on the specified dates up to 14.00 hrs. on payment of **Rs.1000.00** (non refundable) in cash per set **of each tender** from this office and the completed tender papers will be received up to **15.00 hrs.** on **30.11.11** and will be opened at **15.15 hrs.** on the same day in presence of the intending tenderers or their authorized representative.

Intending tenderers shall have to apply, **separately for each Sl. No.**, in writing to the Superintending Engineer, WBIIDC for obtaining permission for issuance of tender papers latest by **18.11.11** up to 14.00 hrs. for all tenders with photo copies (**self attested with company stamp & date**) of credentials regarding satisfactory completion of similar nature of works as mentioned above, along with valid – i. PAN Card, ii. I. T. Return, iii. VAT Registration Certificate, iv. Current P. Tax Challen, V. Completion certificate along with work order enclosing schedule of works etc. as applicable. All the photo copies will be verified from the originals by the estimating section of Electrical / Mechanical division at the time of receiving of the application before last date of submission of application. Application submitted by the applicant without verification of original from Electrical / Mechanical division will be termed as cancelled and the applicant will not be eligible to obtain tender paper. Last date of issue of tender paper on **25.11.11** up to 14.00 hours.

**To obtain tender papers,** the applicant along with his application should also submit the following documents:-

1. The applicant should be either a manufacturer or an authorized representative of a manufacturer who must have designed, manufactured, tested, supplied and commissioned the equipments similar to the type specified in the “Technical Specification”. Documentary evidence is to be furnished by the applicant to obtain tender papers.
2. If the applicant is a **manufacturer**, the minimum turnover from the manufacturing of relevant machines shall be at least Rs. 25 Crores considering total 3 Sl. nos. and 8 Crores for single Sl. no. in minimum two financial years of the last three financial years. Documentary evidence has to be furnished by the applicant to obtain tender papers.
3. If the applicant is an **authorized dealer / distributors / representative**, the minimum turnover from sales and services of relevant machines and equipments shall be at least Rs. 5 Crores considering total 3 Sl. nos. and 1.70 Crores for single Sl. no. in minimum two financial years of the last three financial years. Documentary evidence has to be furnished by the applicant to obtain tender papers.
4. The applicant should have experience of supplying machines meeting the major “Technical Specification” parameters of the machines being procured to Government /Semi-Government /Public Sector Unit /Autonomous bodies /Educational Institutions / Training Institution etc. of a value of minimum Rs. 1.5 Crores considering total 3 Sl. nos. and 0.5 Crores for single Sl. no.in last two years. Documentary evidence has to be furnished by the applicant to obtain tender papers.
5. The applicant must have paid up capital of Rs. 1 Crore considering total 3 Sl. nos. and 0.35 Crores for single Sl. no.
6. The applicant has to provide last 3 years’ Balance Sheet along with his application to obtain tender papers.

**Along with tender, the tenderer should submit the followings:-**

- A. The tenderer should provide quality and safety certifications for all the machines. All the Machines quoted should bear either CE marking or equivalent international certification wherever asked for.

- B. The tenderer shall also demonstrate that the quoted machines matching major specifications have been supplied by him in last three years and that the satisfactory services have been provided by him or his authorized agent /dealer / distributor / representative. The purchaser may enquire independently from the current users of the machines regarding its quality, performance, liability and service support.
- C. If the tenderer is an authorized dealer/ distributor /representative, proper document /letter of authorization signed by the manufacturer shall be submitted by the tenderer in respect of all quoted machines.
- D. Deviation from the technical specification of quoted machine is not permitted. However, if there any minor deviation in the specification /performance of quoted machines, then the said shall be clearly specified, detailed and be elaborately explained along with the catalogue / brochure etc. of the machine.
- E. A brief note including manufacturing and technical parameter on each machine item shall be submitted by the tenderer conforming all the specifications of the machines mentioned in the schedule of “Technical Specification”. Along with the machines tenderers should also have to furnish drawing of support work table.
- F. The tenderes must furnish booklets, technical specification, drawing and guaranty card etc of each machine.

Tenderer should quote their rates inclusive of all charges i.e. S.T., E.D., Transport, Octroi, Insurance, Service Tax, loading & unloading, installation, testing & commissioning of all quoted machines & accessories etc. including cost of support work table, as and where necessary. No extra payment will be made on this score. The tenderer should also note that, no escalation in offered rate will be allowed also no mobilization advance will be allowed.

Intending tenderers along with their tender have to submit 2% (two percent) of quoted value as earnest money along with his offer in favour of **West Bengal Industrial Infra-Structure Development Corporation** in the form of Demand Draft / Pay Order payable at Kolkata, which will be converted to part of security deposit for successful tender. Balance 8% (eight percent) will be deducted from R/A bill to make total security deposit amounting 10%, which will be released after 12 months from successful commission and running of machines. Running Account bill payment may be allowed.

Tenderer are strongly advised to visit place of work.

The successful tenderer will have to execute two copies of contract documents in WBIIDC's Form no.1 with the Superintending Engineer, WBIIDC after payment of Rs.1000/- (non refundable) per set with in 7 days from the date of receipt of letter of acceptance of the Quotation/Work Order failing which the offer shall liable to be terminated and the earnest money as submitted shall stand forfeited without any further reference to the tenderer.

The undersigned reserves the right to reject/accept the Quotation in whole or part thereof without assigning any reason whatsoever.

No person will be allowed to quote rate on the basis of Power of Attorney unless the same is granted by 1<sup>st</sup> Class Executive Magistrate.
